Recognize

- Read very carefully
- Is the address a formal .edu address?
- Do they ask for personal information or for you to click on a link?

Respond

- Don't give out any information
- Hover over the link and see if the url matches the claim

Report

- Forward the email AS AN ATTACHMENT to phish@utah.edu (or spam@utah.edu for spam)

Recover

- Change your passwords to accounts that may have been compromised
